After attending an initial 2-hour training session, students attend a monthly 1-hour meeting at the Breathe California office and review movies for tobacco, all while gaining community service hours for each meeting they attend and each movie they review. Meetings are on the second Monday of each month, from 4pm to 5pm, and always have pizza! Students in the program can also get recommendation and scholarship letters.
