The Kennedy High School PACE Scholarship

The Kennedy High School PACE Scholarship was established to recognize PACE seniors who have strong financial need and have demonstrated the ability to work hard to achieve their goals, and have exhibited a strong commitment to academic excellence, community service and school leadership.

Purpose and Amount

The scholarship amount will vary, but will be at least \$1,000, and more than \$10,000 in PACE scholarships will be awarded. Award recipients may use funds to cover educational-related costs including books, school supplies, computer equipment, lab fees, etc.

Eligibility

To be eligible, an applicant must:

- Be a senior in good academic and citizenship standing who is on target to graduate in the spring
- Have been enrolled in the PACE program for all four years at Kennedy High School
- Demonstrate financial need

Evaluation criteria are prioritized as follows: financial need and special circumstances, academic performance, community service and school leadership.

Selection

The selection committee will review each application from eligible candidates. Finalists will be selected based upon how well they meet the scholarship criteria. Applicants will be notified of the selection committee's decision by May 30, 2010.

Award

The scholarship will be issued over the course of one academic year. Continuous, full-time

enrollment (no fewer than 12 units per quarter/semester) is a requirement. The Sacramento Region Community Foundation will disburse the award directly to the student.

How to Apply

Submit a complete application package by April 19, 2009. Use the following **application package checklist** to make sure your application package is complete:

- A completed application form
- A copy of your completed FAFSA
- A list of your extracurricular and/or community activities including work experience
- Official transcripts, in a sealed envelope
- A typed, double-spaced, self-portrayal essay (maximum 500 words)
